

INCLUSION MOMENT– VETERANS

The CUCC Inclusion Team is focusing on Veterans for the month of November and the consequences of exclusion on the lives of Veterans. **There were around 20.4 million U.S. veterans in 2016**, according to data from the Department of Veterans Affairs, representing less than 10% of the total U.S. adult population. As we lift up Inclusion efforts with Veterans this month, here are key facts about those who have served in the military and how this population is changing. (*2016 data from the Department of Veterans Affairs and the Pew Research Center.*)

Gulf War era veterans now account for the largest share of all U.S. veterans, surpassing Vietnam era veterans in 2016. As of last year, there were 6.8 million American veterans who served during the Vietnam era and 7.1 million who served in the Gulf War era

The share of the U.S. population with military experience is declining. In 2016, 7% of U.S. adults were veterans, down from 18% in 1980. Projections suggest the number of veterans will continue to decline in the coming decades. By 2045, the Department of Veterans Affairs estimates there will be around 12 million veterans, a roughly 40% decrease from current numbers.

The demographic profile of veterans is expected to change in the next few decades. Currently 91% of veterans are men while 9% are women, according to the VA’s 2016 population model estimates. By 2045, the share of female veterans is expected to double to 18%. The number of female veterans is also projected to increase, from around 1.9 million in 2016 to 2.2 million in 2045. Male veterans, on the other hand, are projected to drop by almost half, from 18.5 million in 2016 to 9.8 million in 2045.

In the 2016 Congress, 20% of senators and 19% of representatives have prior military service. The share of senators who are veterans reached a post-Korean War peak of 81% in 1975, while the share among House members peaked in 1967 at 75%
