

Renovation History

Our CUCC Sanctuary needs a facelift! The carpet is threadbare, the chancel backdrop is peeling, and the walls and ceiling are stained. The last time much work was done in the Sanctuary was in 1989 as part of a 20th anniversary (of this building) celebration. At the time, the congregation raised \$50,000+ to remodel the Sanctuary. This was the last time Sanctuary needs were comprehensively addressed.



2023

We have embarked on a campaign for a Sanctuary renovation; the total cost of this project is \$150,000. A summary breakdown of this project is below.

To this end, we have begun a \$150,000 capital campaign for building improvement. As we do, we must emphasize that donations to the capital campaign must be **in addition to Joyful Giving donations, not in place of them.** Any funds raised in excess of what is spent on the detailed projects will be deposited in the Building Fund for future building needs.



Window Sale: We have 45 transom windows to be replaced in our Sanctuary. You have the opportunity to "buy a window" for \$900 each in honor or memory of loved ones. These window donations will be recorded and posted in anniversary bulletins, the Communicator, and in the Sanctuary.

Century Club: You also have the opportunity to join the Century Club for a minimum donation of \$1000. Everyone who donates at this level will receive a free 100th anniversary book, a special "Century Club" coffee mug, and a "Century Club" pin, as well as recognition in anniversary bulletins and the Communicator.



Fundraisers: We will have quarterly fundraisers in 2023 dedicated to this effort. We will work with Ministry Teams to implement some of these Ideas, possibly in conjunction with Fellowship events (such as a dessert auction at the Chili Cookoff). Other fundraising ideas we may embark upon include: 100th anniversary t-shirts, mugs, etc.; a rummage sale; a Food Truck Fair; and a Car Show. Some of these events will also serve as publicity to the community about our church and location
