SPECIAL MISSION PROJECT PROPOSAL

The Church Council, putting together the **2018** CUCC Budget, decided to dream big with a grand ministry plan and budgeted an extra amount of money to be used for a “Special Mission Project” to be determined at a later date. After some discernment by the congregation last year, guided by the Outreach and Advocacy Ministry Team, that money was given to Camp MoVal to refurbish one of their cabins.

In our **2019** budget, the Church Council decided to repeat this ministry goal and budgeted **\$5750 for a “Special Mission Project.”** The Outreach and Advocacy Ministry Team, after some discernment about possible projects, has decided to recommend to the Church Council that we spend this money on our Global Missions Ministries in Chiapas, disbursed as follows:

\$3000 to INESIN for their ongoing programs, including their Reforestation Program

\$2750 to Melel Xojobal for their work with the children of Chiapas
