Theodulph of Orléans, 9th century Transl. John Mason Neale, 1854; alt. Matt. 21:8-9



Brought to France by Charlemagne, Theodulph became bishop of Orléans but was later imprisoned by Charlemagne's successor. According to legend, he was released when the king, Louis the Pious, heard him sing this hymn from prison.

Elizabeth Clephane was known during her short lifetime for her charitable work in her hometown of Melrose, Scotland. After her death, this hymn was compiled from several stanzas of a longer poem that had appeared in a popular Scottish religious magazine.

The unknown editor of Lyra Davidica wanted music with more movement and spirit than found in the grave, slow-paced psalm tunes, with one note to a syllable. Easter Hymn; was among the first of a new popular style.

John of Damascus, 8th century Transl. John Mason Neale, 1862; alt. Mark 16:1-6




